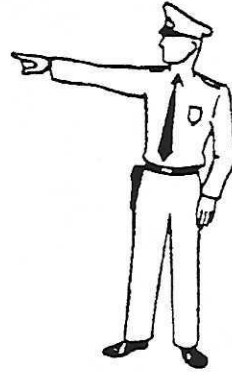
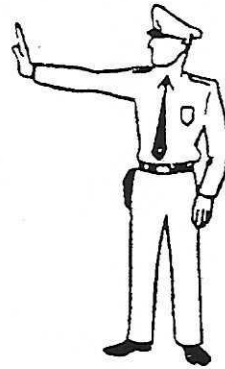


DIRECTING TRAFFIC
By using
GESTURES AND SIGNALS

Look and point at traffic
in one direction.



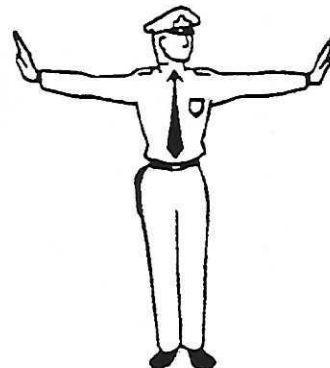
Hold hand in stop position
for that direction until
traffic has stopped.



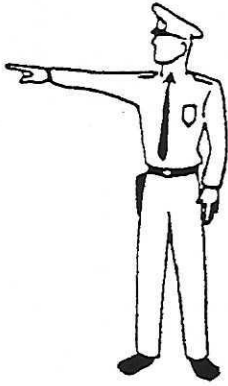
Look and point at traffic
in other direction.



Hold hand in stop position for
that direction. Don't lower either
arm until vehicles approaching
from both ways are stopped.

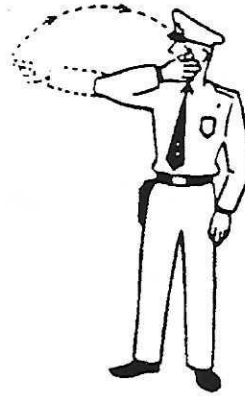

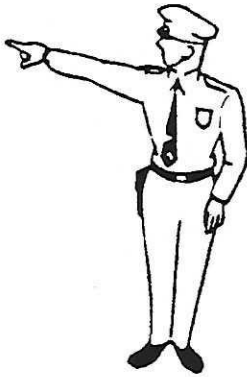
Point toward vehicle you want to start moving.

-- STARTING --

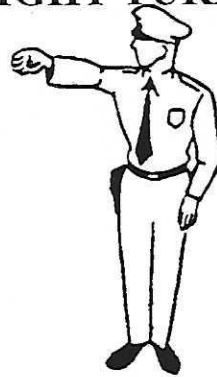


Motion with arm to start traffic stream moving.

-- RIGHT TURN --



To indicate right turn, point at driver with your arm.

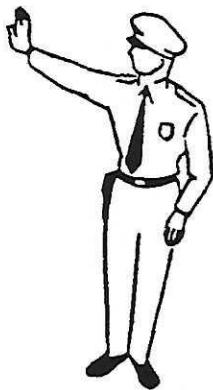


Swing your arm to point out right turn direction.

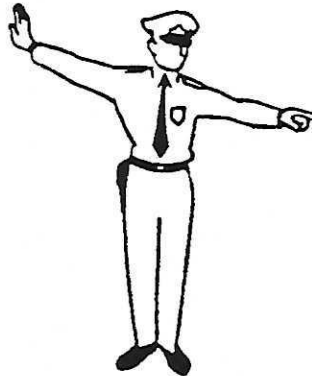


Keep pointing until right turn has been made.

-- LEFT TURN --



Stop traffic for a Left turn with one hand. driver,



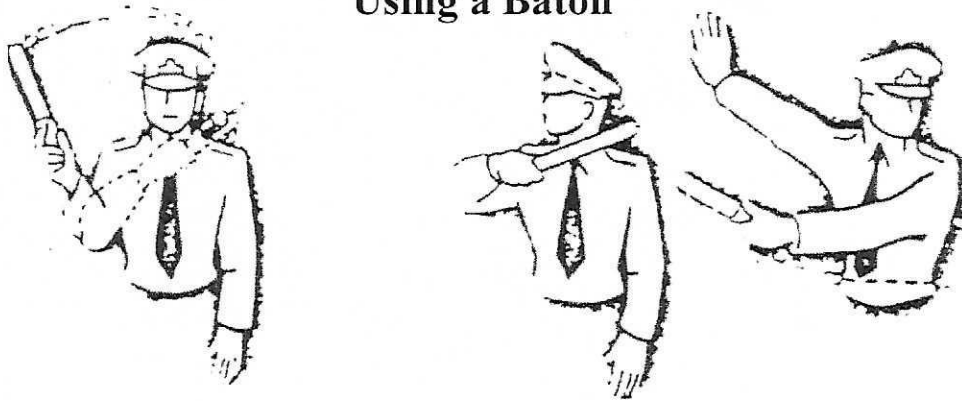
Hold opposing traffic with one point to turning driver, left hand.



Give left turn signal with left hand - with one hand.

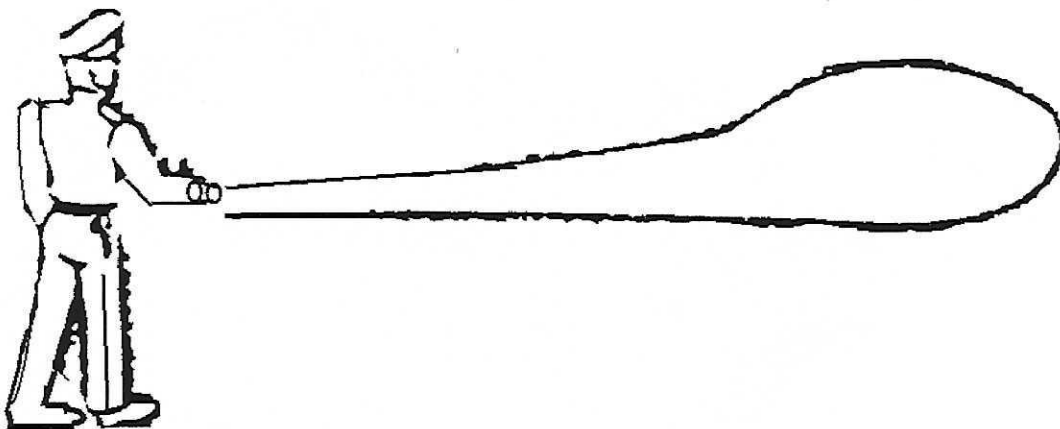
NIGHT TRAFFIC DIRECTION
